Each stakeholder (group) has its own set of objectives and priorities and must carry out different actions to help resolve the incident.

If priorities and objectives are not aligned between the stakeholders, the end results are a failing response. Each operational period of the game results in real world discussions about best practices for response and how to maintain priority objectives. Through each round participants see the situation develop, will be required to respond, and will see the consequence of their decisions.
