Resolutions 230912-18 to 230912-22

I allow Resolutions 230912-18 to 230912-22 with the revision that Councillor Foat's vote must be removed and shown as abstaining as required under s. s. 184(a) of the Municipal Government Act ("MGA").

The minutes I have been provided by the City identify that Councillor Foat was present "via Webex until 1:33 p.m.").

At the start of the meeting, the Mayor did not announce that Councillor Foat was attending via Webex. Councillor Foat did not participate in the meeting via Webex to my knowledge until after 1:33 pm at which time he attended the meeting in person.

Councillor Foat's vote on Resolutions 230912-01 - Resolution 230912-09 is listed as "NOT RECORDED".

The Municipal Government Act allows a municipality to pass a bylaw to provide for council meetings to be conducted via electronic means. Electronic means "means an electronic or telephone communication method that enables **all persons attending a meeting to hear and communicate with each other** during the course of the meeting" (MGA, s. 199(1)(a), emphasis added).

The bylaw to allow council meetings to be held via electronic means must:

- specify the type or types of electronic means by which meetings are authorized to be held,
- require the identity of each councillor attending the meeting to be confirmed by a method authorized by the bylaw, (MGA, s. 199(3)(a)-(b)).

The City has passed a bylaw to allow council meetings to be held by electronic means, the Procedure Bylaw which requires:

- 5.5.2 ... Members participating in Meeting through electronic means may participate in any Closed Sessions held at that Meeting and are required to vote on a matter put to a vote at the meeting unless the Member is required or permitted to abstain from voting under this or any other enactment.
- 5.5.8. The Chair must announce at the Meeting that a Member is participating through electronic means.

I have asked for details regarding when Councillor Foat logged into the Webex link and how his attendance was confirmed. The City has not provided me with these details.

It appears Councillor Foat was not in attendance, at least not in a manner that is required under the MGA and the Procedure Bylaw, for the portion of the Council Meeting addressed by Resolution 230912-01 – 230912-09. He did not ask questions through his Webex Link. He did not vote using his Webex Link.

Councillors in attendance at a Council Meeting are required to vote. (MGA, s. 183(1)).

I find that Councillor Foat was not in attendance for Resolutions 230912-01 –230912-09. He was not in attendance using an electronic means that allowed him to communicate with the other attendees as his vote is unrecorded.

As Councillor Foat was not in attendance for the public hearing on Municipal Development Plan Amendments - East Acreages, North Acreages, Paradise Meadows MDP Amendments, he should have abstained from voting. (MGA, s. 184(a))

Resolution 230912-28

As noted in the Cuff Report, Council struggles with drafting motions. Resolution 230912-28 is an example of a motion which is not clearly stated or written.

I have reviewed Bylaw 023-23 as shown in the agenda package.

It appears what is being proposed to be replaced by the first bullet is:

A Bylaw of the City of Chestermere, in the Province of Alberta, to amend the Municipal Development Plan (Bylaw 015-15) of the City of Chestermere to provide infill residential development standards *for the East Acreage, North Acreages, and Paradise Meadows areas*.

With Council's amendments, Bylaw 023-23 would read:

A Bylaw of the City of Chestermere, in the Province of Alberta, to amend the Municipal Development Plan (Bylaw 015-15) of the City of Chestermere to provide infill residential development standards *to amend MDP Figure 8 – Land Use Concept.*

I am unclear why "to provide infill residential development standards" has remained in the preamble. I allow Resolution 230912-28 with the addition that "to provide infill residential development standards" is also replaced so that the preamble to Bylaw 023-23 is coherent.

I note there appears to be some comment from Administration that I had issues with City Council amending bylaws at second reading and this is why Resolution 230912-28 was brought forward at this Council meeting rather then at second reading.

In general, Council may amend a bylaw after a public hearing after considering representations made to it at the public hearing and after considering any other matter it considered appropriate. It is entirely appropriate for Council to amend bylaws after a public hearing and provided for under s. 216.4(5)(b) of the MGA.

I disallowed Resolutions 230627-06 to 230627-15 at the June 27, 2023 City Council meeting because Council amended the area to which the bylaw applied to include a significant amount of additional land. The individuals who lived in those areas would not have had notice that the proposed bylaw applied to them.

In that case, City Council's amendment after the public hearing raised a significant concern of procedural fairness. As such, I disallowed Resolutions 230627-06 to 230627-15.

My decision in respect of Resolutions 230627-06 to 230627-15 However, this should not be taken by the City as an indication that it is never permissible to amend a bylaw after a public hearing.
