
Access the portal

Open your browser (Google Chrome is recommended) and access the online application portal: https://edtgrants.edt.gov.ab.ca/


Or, you can access the portal via the FTTC webpage.



Alberta.ca Account

Once an account has been created, applicants will gain access to the online application portal that hosts forms and templates required for application.




Corporations that are not yet registered in Alberta are able to apply for the FTTC program. However, please note that Authorization Letters will only be issued to an Alberta corporation.
