**S.E.F. NO. 101
PUBLIC PASSENGER VEHICLES ENDORSEMENT**

(For attachment only to a Standard Excess Automobile Policy S.P.F. No. 7)

In consideration of a premium charged it is understood and agreed as follows:

1. Only as respects loss or damage resulting from bodily injury to, or the death of any occupant of the automobile and only as respects loss of or damage to property carried in or upon the automobile; of the limit shown in item 4 of the Application for a contract of excess automobile insurance, S.P.F. No. 7, claims against the Insured by occupants of the vehicle shall have priority over all other claims as follows:

a) \$ ----- (exclusive of interest and costs) for loss or damage resulting from bodily injury to or the death of any one such person and, subject to such limit for any one such person so injured or killed,

\$----- (exclusive of interest and costs) for loss or damage resulting from bodily injury to or the death of two or more such persons in any one accident, and

\$----- (exclusive of interest and costs) for loss of or damage to property resulting from any one accident;

or

b) \$----- (exclusive of interest and costs) in respect to bodily injury to or the death of one or more passengers.

The coverage provided by this policy and endorsement is excess insurance to coverage provided by any SPF No. 1 Owners Policy issued to the insured and any underlying excess insurance stated in item 5 of the application.

Except as otherwise provided in this endorsement, all limits, terms, conditions, provisions, definitions and exclusions of the SPF No. 7 policy shall have full force and effect.

Re: SEF No. 6c Public Passenger Vehicle Endorsement

and

SEF No. 101 Public Passenger Vehicle Endorsement

Effective immediately the SEF No. 6c and SEF No. 101 endorsements are amended by removing the following wording from section 2(ii)(b) of the SEF No. 6c endorsement and from section 1 (b) of the SEF No. 101 endorsement

... “and losses of or damage to the passengers’ property in one accident”.

The amendment will apply immediately to all SEF No. 6c and SEF No. 101 endorsements that are in force, issued or renewed.

The amendment is necessary so that policyholders can meet the passenger hazard insurance requirement imposed by regulations under the *Traffic Safety Act*.

Please alert your underwriting staff and Alberta insurance agents of the revisions to the SEF No. 6c and SEF No. 101 endorsements.
